Update on Dunvant Road from Coal Authority to the Council

We have now received costs from the contractor to carry out the work. Due to the value of the work this has to go through our due diligence process.

I called to site last week and spoke with some of the residents to explain there will now be a delay while this process is carried out.

The contractor has provided a lead time of approximately 4-6 weeks to mobilise from the time that the order is placed with them.

The likelihood is that the work will start early January as the residents that I spoke with agreed that they would not want the work to start just before Christmas and then the contractor leave site for their 2 week Christmas break.

I will update you when I have further information regarding the engagement of the contractor after our processes have been completed.
