# **City Councillors J & M Jones**

# Gas leak

As some of you may already be aware we have been told that a gas leak has been detected near the pedestrian crossing between Olchfa school and Miller and Carter.

Wales and West Utilities are planning to carry out the repair during Half Term w/c Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> October. They are intending to start work on the Sunday and at this time we are unaware of the time it will take. As they must close the carriageway on the south side of Gower Road there will be temporary traffic lights, and this is going to cause disruption to Killay residents and further afield.

# Daffodils

We met with the Council officer to decide where to put our daffodil bulbs and the areas in Killay are

Ffordd Taliesin along the fence line near the Post Box and Defibrillator. This is to extend the area we have planted previously.

As a request we are planting on the grass verge (North side) of Gower Rd from Killay Precinct towards the traffic lights.

Landor Avenue near the junction with Wimmerfield Drive.

## **Resilient Swansea Workshop**

Jeff and I attended this workshop which was on behalf of the Swansea Signatories Group and the Public Services Board of the Council. Although it was held in Upper Killay it was the nearest one for us to attend.

The aim is to consult with residents about their priorities for tackling climate change. By early 2025 the aim is to publish a strategy followed by an action plan within the same year. (Rhiannon and Sarah also attended)

## **Broadband engagement session**

We attended a Broadband session in Killay Library the aim of which was to inform residents that as part of the City Deal the aim is that every home and business in the Swansea Bay region will have access to full fibre or mobile broadband capable of up to 1 Gbit/s, 30 times faster than superfast broadband. It was very interesting.
