KI114

Footpath KI114 has become extremely overgrown with fern and bracken. The path is currently very difficult to navigate and you cannot see the path in front of you. Walkers get very wet walking amongst the over growth!

KI105

Another path very over grown making it difficult for horse riders to safely navigate . Lots of low branches and obstructive trees.

KI102
