Footpath KI 114

On Thursday May 16th Chris Dale, Manager of the Countryside Access Team informed me and other supporters that KI 114 is now reopened. This is the result of a three-year negotiation with the tenant farmer of Lledglawdd farm. The PRoW committee first reported the obstruction on August 23rd, 2021. Three kissing gates have now been installed to ensure the safety of livestock grazing in the fields through which the path runs. It is important now that users act responsibly and follow the Countryside Code.
