Chris Dale will arrange the clearing of the Northern end of the path and the removal of the “no horses” sign. He is reluctant to clear the Southern end due to the wildlife habitat the growth provides and it is now the nesting season. He says that there is a discrepancy between the used route and the legal route and comments that both the path and the playing field are used rarely these days but will follow our guidance and local knowledge.

Killay Community Council Chair has provided a series of photos showing the path over the past 20 years which shows a difference in the latest one Chris Dale has provided.

The chair says the gravel path was built by the council to allow users to walk around the playing field. This and the playing field is used regularly by locals. Chris has been sent this information.

We will advise him if we wish him to take further action.

Arwyddion/Signage KI113 and KI114.

Chris Dale agreed that signage would be useful at the Killay end and Waunarlwydd end of KI113. KI114 has no clear destination so as is the practice, a yellow way mark has been provided at both ends of KI114
